

Joyce Ann Wilson (1931–2007)

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The Editors of the Bulletin sadly notify its readers of the death of one of its Associate Editors, Joyce Ann Wilson, March 2nd 2007. She was 75 years old.

Joyce was born in Benton Harbor, Michigan; she attended Michigan State University, receiving her Bachelor of Science degree in 1953 focusing on child development. She met and married Barry Wilson in 1956 while working for the Quaker Oats Company in Chicago. The couple moved to Los Angeles, California the next year where she worked for the Carnation Company, while her husband studied for his PhD at UCLA. They moved to Davis

California in 1962, where her husband joined the faculty of the University of California. Joyce was secretary of the Unitarian Church of Davis for many years and active in many community activities. Recently, she served as Associate Editor of the Bulletin of Environmental Contamination and Toxicology, reviewing manuscripts and assisting authors in readying their work for publication.

Joyce Wilson was known for her twinkling eyes, her ready smile, and gentle wit. The Bulletin will miss her voluntary selfless efforts to improve the practice of science and its reporting.
