Memorial Sloan-Kettering to Host International Cancer Research Conference

The Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center will host an international conference on cancer research, "Cancer 1980: Achievements, Challenges, Prospects," in New York September 13–18. The conference, which is jointly sponsored by Memorial Sloan-Kettering, the American Cancer Society and the National Cancer Institute, will present progress in cancer research and treatment during the ten years of the National Cancer Program.

The New York Conference will be followed by an International Conference on Ageing and Cancer, to be held in Washington, D.C. on September 21–26. The Washington meeting, which is presented by the National Cancer Institute and sponsored by NCI and the Bankers Life and Casualty Company, will discuss future directions for cancer research and research on the ageing process, focusing primarily on the status of basic research.

Orientated to the scientific and medical community, the five-day conference will include discussions on the etiology of cancer, mechanisms of malignant transformation, diagnosis, and treatment of various types of cancer with chemotherapy, radiation, surgery and immunotherapy.

The conference will be held at the Grand Hyatt Hotel, New York City. Registration fee is \$ 250.00.
