International Symposium on Hormonotherapy in Oncology

March 23 – 25, 1988
Bologna, Italy

This Symposium will focus on the theme of hormonotherapy in oncology. Basic questions will be faced (etiology, epidemiology, receptors, pharmacokinetics) as well as specifically clinical questions regarding treatment strategies for breast, prostate, endometrium, ovarian and renal cancers. There will also be a Session on supportive therapies (cancer pain, the cachexia etc.) and at the end a treatment strategy will be proposed for early and advanced breast cancer – the fruit of collaboration among the most important experts in the field. It will be presented under the title: “Bologna Declaration”. Both research workers and general practitioners can make this proposed treatment a safe reference point for a better approach to this kind of disease.

Many top research Scientists have been invited from various parts of the world (USA, USSR, East Germany, West Germany, Holland, Belgium, Switzerland, France, Spain, Britain, Yugoslavia, Hungary, Japan, Scandinavia).

The opening Lecture will be delivered by Prof. J. H. Tagnon on the theme:
Hormonotherapy in oncology: past, present and future.
