

Publisher's note

The new United States Copyright Law came into effect on 1 January 1978. In order to conform with the provisions of this law, users of this journal should note the following:

— Authors resident in the U.S.A. will be asked to transfer copyright, in writing, on a form provided by the Regional Editor to whom a manuscript has been submitted.

— Readers will notice that most papers carry a multi-digit code at the foot of their first page. This code signifies that Elsevier Scientific Publishing Company participates in the non-profit Copyright Clearance Center. The Center will approve copying beyond that legally permitted in the U.S.A., provided that the fee established by the publisher and details of the material copied are sent to the Center. The fee for each copy of all or part of a paper is stated in the final digits of the code. The address of the Copyright Clearance Center, to which the fee is to be paid, is mentioned on the inside cover of the journal.
