International Carbohydrate Award in Honour of Roy L. Whistler

The first International Carbohydrate Award in honour of Roy L. Whistler was presented to Dr. Tomoya Ogawa by the International Carbohydrate Organisation (I.C.O.) in Utrecht, The Netherlands in July 1984 at the XIIth International Carbohydrate Symposium. The award consists of a commemorative plaque accompanied by a very substantial cash award.

Nominations are invited for the second Award to be presented at the XIIIth International Carbohydrate Symposium in Cornell University, Ithaca, U.S.A. in 1986 when the recipient will give a plenary lecture. Nominations should be sent to the I.C.O. national representative of the nominee's country, or country of current residence, or to the I.C.O. Secretary, Dr. K. C. B. Wilkie (Chemistry Department, University of Aberdeen, Meston Walk, Old Aberdeen AB9 2UE).

Nominations should arrive by mid-April 1985; those after this date may not be considered. An outline of reasons for nominations should be given. Those nominated should be active workers in carbohydrate research who have made contributions of excellence and who have the qualities indicative of continued productivity of like quality.
