3rd International Hydrocolloids Conference

Hydrocolloids 1996—New Challenges, New Opportunities 11–16 August 1996 Sydney, Australia

The Third International Hydrocolloids Conference will be held on August 11–16, 1996 at the Landmark Park Royal Hotel, Potts Point in Sydney, Australia. The event is sponsored by the CSIRO and the Co-operative Research Centre for Industrial Plant Biopolymers and builds on the previous conferences in Japan 1992 and the USA in 1994.

The Conference will focus on the new industrial opportunities for hydrocolloids in important areas, including foods, nutritional products, pharmaceuticals, health and personal care products, and agricultural and veterinary products. To meet these challenges, the Conference will discuss novel production and processing techniques.

Leading speakers from North America, Europe, Japan, and Australia will present their latest basic and applied research findings, and a special feature will be the emphasis on novel hydrocolloids systems and the relationships between structure and function.

Professor G.O. Phillips is the Conference Patron, Professor K. Nishinari is the Conference President, and Dr Alan Lane is the Conference Chairman.

Contributed papers are invited from academia, industry, and research organisations and may be presented either orally or as a poster. There will also be a trade display and opportunities for sponsorship.
