## The Carbohydrate Research Award 2001

The *Carbohydrate Research* Award for Creativity in Carbohydrate Chemistry was established in 2001 by the Editors and the Publisher of *Carbohydrate Research*.

The Carbohydrate Research Award consists of a cheque for US\$ 1,000, a certificate and a complimentary subscription to Carbohydrate Research for two years. The Award is presented to a carbohydrate scientist who has made significant original contributions to the field, in its broadest sense. The winner is invited to present a lecture on their work at an international conference, and to publish a paper based on their research in Carbohydrate Research.
