The Nordic Symposium on Catalysis is a gathering of scientists and engineers for the exchange of information on recent developments and new ideas within the field of catalysis and for the promotion of co-operation between the Nordic Countries. The symposium is an annual event under the auspices of the Nordic Catalysis Society. The event will be hosted annually by the four countries in turn. Having been in Lyngby, Denmark (1989), in Helsinki, Finland (1990) and in Trondheim, Norway (1991), Lund will be in turn again for the event in 1992.

We invite contributions covering fundamental and applied aspects of catalysis as well as catalysis-related reaction engineering. The language of the conference will be English.
