

ANNOUNCEMENT/CALL FOR PAPERS

6th International Symposium on CATALYST DEACTIVATION

The 511th event of the European Federation of Chemical Engineering is to be held on 3rd-5th October 1994, at the Termae Palace Hotel, Koningi Astridlaan 7, 8400 Oostende, Belgium.

This Symposium is a continuation of the series of symposia on Catalyst Deactivation held in Berkeley, 1978, Antwerp, 1980, Berkeley, 1985, Antwerp, 1987, and Evanston, 1991. It will also be an activity of the Working Party "Chemical Engineering in the Applications of Catalysis" of the European Federation of Chemical Engineering.

The objective of this symposium is to promote a scientific approach to the phenomenon of catalyst deactivation which would contribute to the development of catalysts less subject to structural transformations and more resistant to poisons and coke formation.

Those interested in presenting a paper are invited to submit an abstract (2 pages) before 1.10.93. Authors will be informed on 1.12.93 of the acceptance of their paper based on this abstract. The complete text of the paper is due on 1.3.94.

Final acceptance will be notified on 1.4.93.
