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The cover picture shows an electron micrograph of *Bacillus subtilis* before (inset) and after treatment with an acyldepsipeptide (ADEP, structure shown), which blocks cell division to produce filamented cell structures. Exploration of the synthesis of enopeptin-type acyldepsipeptide antibiotics has led to new compounds with improved in vitro antibiotic activity against Gram-positive pathogens and in vivo activity in mouse models of lethal infection.
