Galpha-positive cells are found in the tammar's receptor epithelium having their cell nuclei mainly in the basal part of the epithelium. Nerve bundles stretching alongside the vomeronasal organ are also Galpha-positive. All other not epithelial staining; blood vessels are marked by arrow heads. No staining was seen in the IgG control.
