Chemical Society Reviews

As announced in the last issues of both *Quarterly Reviews* (Vol. 25, 1971, No. 4) and *RIC Reviews* (Vol. 4, 1971, No. 2), these two review periodicals are now replaced by one new review publication, *Chemical Society Reviews*.

The new periodical is not simply a mixture of its two predecessors. It does, however, constitute a logical continuation of both, and aims to provide articles of interest to a wide readership. The articles will range over the whole of chemistry and its interfaces with other disciplines, and there will be a conscious attempt to provide consistency of depth of treatment, so that each article is of interest to chemists in general, and not merely to those with a specialist interest in the subject being reviewed.

Chemical Society Reviews will appear quarterly, and should comprise approximately 25 articles (600pp) per annum. Although the majority of articles will be specially commissioned, the Society will always be prepared to consider offers of articles for publication. In such cases a short synopsis should be submitted rather than the completed article, to The Editor, Reports and Reviews Section, The Chemical Society, Burlington House, Piccadilly, London, W1V 0BN.
