**ACADEMICIAN
OLEG NIKOLAEVICH CHUPAKHIN
(on his 75th jubilee)**

The 75th anniversary of the Full Member of the Russian Academy of Science, Doctor of Chemical Sciences, Professor Oleg Nikolaevich Chupakhin, is celebrated on 9 June 2009.

O. N. Chupakhin, one of the most outstanding organic chemists has founded a large scientific school. Its work in organic, heterocyclic, and medicinal chemistry has obtained a wide recognition both in our country and abroad.

O. N. Chupakhin is the author of 11 monographs, more than 500 papers and scientific communications, and more than 200 patents and inventions. Oleg Nikolaevich is in charge of intensive scientific educational work as the head of Organic Chemistry Department in the Ural State Technical University. His works are used as texts in Moscow State University, Rostov, Novosibirsk, Ural Technical, and other universities, introduced into textbooks and guides.

O. N. Chupakhin focused a great attention to the training of personnel of higher skill. Among these students are more than 40 candidates and 9 doctors of science. He organized filials of the Department of Organic Chemistry of the Ural State and Ural State Technical University, and the High-molecular Compounds Laboratory of the Ural State University based on the Institute of Organic Chemistry, Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences, which works now successfully.

Oleg Nikolaevich – President of the Associated Science Council of the Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences for Chemical Science, President of the Special Committee on the defense of doctoral dissertations, member of the Russian National Committee of Chemists, member of the Editorial Board of the "Zhurnal Organicheskoi Khimii" (Russian Journal of Organic Chemistry), member of the Editorial Board

of "Vestnik Ural'skogo otdeleniya RAN" (Journal of the Ural Branch, Russian Academy of Sciences), member of the International Heterocyclic Society, member of International Union of Antiviral Compounds, member of the International Scientific Committee on Conventional Problems of Chemical and Biological Weapons.

Oleg Nikolaevich was awarded the Prize of the USSR Council of the Ministers (1990), the D. I. Mendeleev All-Union Chemical Society Prize (1986), and the International Academic Publisher "Nauka" Prize (1998). In 2004 he was awarded the N. D. Zelinsky Prize, established by the Russian Academy of Science, and the Academician I. Ya. Postovskii Prize, established by the Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences, and in 2008 the V.N. Tatishchev and G. W. de Gennin Prize. In 2006 Oleg Nikolaevich received the prestigious Demidov Prize, and in 2007 the Fund for the Creation of National Science named Oleg Nikolaevich the winner of the 2007 competition as "Prominent Scientist of the Russian Academy of Science".

Oleg Nikolaevich Chupakhin has been awarded the Order of Friendship (1995) and the Order of Honor (2003).
