Persons wishing to offer an oral contribution or poster must submit a title and short synopsis (not more than 100 words) indicating the Section concerned **NOT LATER THAN 31 OCTOBER 1984** for oral contributions: and **NOT LATER THAN 28 FEBRUARY 1985** for posters.

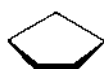
