

PREFACE

The aim of this volume, as with previous volumes in the series (see the cumulative index, p. 339), is to provide a reasonably comprehensive coverage of the coordination chemistry of the *d*-transition metal elements. The reviews in this volume (the last of three to survey 1981) cover publications which appeared during late 1980 and 1981, using primary journals and Volumes 94 and 95 of Chemical Abstracts as the sources for the information. The scope and organisation of the reviews remains unchanged, and I continue to encourage authors to highlight areas of especial interest and relevance to the chemistry of their individual elements.

I apologise to readers, and especially to Frank Hartley and Reg Davis, for the late appearance of this volume. The two articles, for which I am still awaiting manuscripts, will appear as supplements to future volumes.

I am indebted to three people for the production of this volume in its camera-ready copy form. Della Wilkinson and Collette Doughty slaved for many an evening over a hot light-box to produce the majority of the illustrations for Chapters 1 and 2, and Mrs. Brenda Hall's immaculate and accurate typing is responsible for the pleasing appearance of the volume. I wish to thank the three of them for their hard work, which was so willingly and cheerfully given, and (of course) Dr. E.A. Seddon for her help in assembling the finished manuscript.
