PUBLISHER'S NOTE

The readers of our journal will note from the text on the inside cover of this issue that some change is in the air. The publisher's management of *Coordination Chemistry Reviews* will be transferred from Amsterdam, Netherlands to Lausanne, Switzerland from the 1993 subscription block, i.e. from Volume 122 onwards.

The reason for this change is to provide the journal with stronger synergistic support by ensuring it is part of a package of related journals. Elsevier Sequoia in Lausanne already publishes two major journals within the area of inorganic chemistry, viz. *Inorganic Chimica Acta* and the *Journal of Organometallic Chemistry*. The staff in Lausanne have thus gained the best experience over the years as regards managing journals covering inorganic chemistry.

For the authors and readers of Coordination Chemistry Reviews, the change will have little or no effect. The editor, desk editor, typesetter and binder will all continue their involvement with the journal. Apart from general management of the journal, the only major change will be that subscription fulfilment will in future be carried out by Elsevier Sequoia from Lausanne.
