
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WHO DOES YOUR DOG THINK HE IS?



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FEED YOUR BRAIN

ost people would agree that our brains (and our souls) form the very essence of who we are. With brain function naturally declining with age and the incidence of Alzheimer's disease increasing, any steps that can be taken to protect the brain from the ravages of aging are important. One of the best ways to protect brain function is to provide this important organ with the nutrients it needs to protect itself against free radical damage. Need some guidance? Here are four of the best foods for healthy brain function.

BEST FOODS FOR THE BRAIN: BLUEBERRIES

Blueberries are a rich source of anthocyanins, powerful antioxidants that appear to protect the brain against oxidative damage. A study published in Nutritional Neuroscience showed that mice with a genetic predisposition towards Alzheimer's disease experienced less loss of brain function when fed a diet supplemented with blueberry extract than did mice given regular food. The researchers observed that the mice given blueberry

extract had higher levels of enzymes known as kinases which appear to play an important role in brain function and memory. If you don't like the taste of blueberries, there are companies that sell freeze dried blueberries ground into a powder form that can be added to cereals and smoothies.

BEST FOODS FOR THE BRAIN: WALNUTS


Walnuts are a healthy source of omega-3 fatty acids which help to reduce free radical formation and reduce inflammation which can have harmful effects on brain function. Walnut extract is even being investigated as a possible treatment for Alzheimer's disease. Besides potentially improving brain function, walnuts have other beneficial health properties including reducing the risk of heart disease. How much do you need to get these benefits? Most experts recommend around an ounce each day.


BEST FOODS FOR THE BRAIN: CHOCOLATE


Not only has chocolate been shown to improve the mood of people suffering from depression, it also helps to improve brain function in the short term. In one study, subjects who consumed dark chocolate scored better on tests of cognitive performance than those who avoided the dark stuff. Although it's unclear what component of dark chocolate increases brain function, researchers believe it's the flavonoids.

BEST FOODS FOR THE BRAIN: RED WINE

Although if you drink too much of it your brain may not function well in the short term, when consumed in lower quantities red wine is a brain friendly food. The active ingredient appears to be a compound known as resveratrol found in red grape skins. One study showed that mice given red wine extract developed forty percent less brain damage from stroke than mice who didn't receive this supplement. How much do you need? Most experts believe two glasses a day is sufficient to get the benefits.













2009 NOVITEC TULESTO

There are many fascinating automobiles money can buy but its spectacular design, its uncompromising high-performance concept and its limited edition of just eleven cars make the new NOVITEC TuLesto the most exclusive high-end sports car in the world. The mid-engine racer is 204 centimeters wide and weighs in at just 1,260 kilograms. It is built by German automobile manufacturer NOVITEC in Stetten in Bavaria. At the heart of the two-seater is a V8 engine with dual superchargers and a rated power output of 777 hp / 571.8 kW. Thanks to its carbon fiber and aluminum construction the coupe has an excellent power-to-weight ratio of just 1.62 kg/hp. The result is driving performance that only very few super sports cars can match: The sprint from rest to 100 km/h takes less than 3.4 seconds, and the NOVITEC TuLesto reaches 300 km/h after just 22.6 seconds. Top speed is more than 350 km/h.

The new high-end sports car represents NOVITEC's first proprietary car and marks the company's 20th anniversary. "With the NOVITEC TuLesto we transform our collective know-how from two decades of automobile tuning into an uncompromising high-performance sports car for eleven of our long-time customers from around the world," says NOVITEC managing director Wolfgang Hagedorn. "The TuLesto offers an optimal symbiosis of exceptional driving dynamics and exciting yet aerodynamically efficient styling."

2009 WHEELSANDMORE SHELBY GT500 ELEANOR

Customizing exclusive and exotic cars is one of the specialities from german tuner and wheel-manufactur Wheelsandmore, located in Baesweiler near Aachen.

It seems that the crew added their current wheel 6Sporz perfectly to the legendary Ford Mustang Shelby GT500.

In fact, it's a totally customized Ford Mustang S-Code Fastback, built in 1967, having a 5,7L Ford V8-engine with a Shelby GT 500 Bodykit.

To retain most of the 350 horsepower, Wheelsandmore optimized the weight of their forged $20^{\prime\prime}$ rims by using FEM-analysis and took stainless steel outside rims of the highest quality.

By finishing those high-end-wheels with titanium screws the weight depends about $24\ \mathrm{lbs}$.

On the front axle they took a 9.0x20'' with 235/30/20 and on the rear axle 10.5x20 with 275/30/20 Pirelli PZero Nero.


No Kissing On The First Date: In fact, no kissing at all. Ever. This is the epitome of the new romance, that a woman yearns for but never consummates
