Handbook of Carcinogen Testing

This comprehensive, multi-author text is likely to become established a major, authoritative resource text in the area of carcinogen testing. As is inevitable with a multi-author book there is some difference in style, level and content. For example, some authors include a long list of references - some as late as 1983 - while other chapters give only a quite brief list of references with few, if any, later than 1980. The reviewer was somewhat disappointed by the subject index which is not very detailed. For a book of this type which is very likely to be used in the "phone directory" rather than the "novel" mode this limitation may well prove a disadvantage to some users.

This book is recommended for all who are concerned with carcinogen testing.
