The quality of the published manuscripts continues to be high. Expert reviews from over 450 scientists are recognized in this issue. Our thanks to the reviewers for continuing to enhance the peer review commitment of the journal and Editorial Board.

I would like to welcome several new Editorial Board members: Dr. Andreas Bernkop-Schnuerch (Leopold-Franzens University Innsbruck); Dr. Vishal Gupta (Tyco Healthcare Mallinckrodt); Dr. Fiona McInnes (University of Strathclyde); Dr. Hugh Smyth (University of New Mexico); and Dr. Paul M. Young (University of Sydney). These new members are outstanding contributors to science and I look forward to their stewardship.

The Editorial Board members continue to encourage publication of high impact manuscripts. For 2005, the rejection rate of manuscripts submitted to the journal was about 50%, which is higher than that of 2004. The impact factor continues to increase since 2001. The impact factor was 0.787 for 2005. Importantly, the electronic page views were up significantly over 100% for the issue page, abstract page and full-text page.
