


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#### Cover Story

The keynote review in this issue of *Drug Discovery Today*, by Gergely Szakács, András Váradi, Csilla Özvegy-Laczka and Balázs Sarkadi, discusses how human ATP-Binding Cassette (ABC) transporters modulate the pharmacological effects of various drugs.
