Beginning in April 2011 De Gruyter will no longer charge authors for the inclusion of colour illustrations in the printed editions of all of its journals. Free colour illustrations have been the rule for online versions of its journals since 2009.

In the sciences and medicine we can now implement a long-held wish of many editors and authors throughout the world

and discontinue charging for colour illustrations completely. This greatly increases the value of the majority of the contributions in our specialist journals, as it means an increase in the visual clarity and precision of academic communication. Today colour illustrations are extremely common, and are often the most efficient form of satisfactorily conveying complicated content, graphics or diagrams. With this decision De Gruyter moves to the head of the field. We invite all authors to make use of every possibility for the optimising of academic exchange.
