Color Atlas of Oral Diseases—2nd edition
George Laskaris, Thieme, 1994

SIX YEARS after the appearance of the first English edition of this atlas by George Laskaris, is the arrival of the second English edition.

This revised edition contains over eighty new illustrations and contains new sections on renal disease and of course, HIV disease. The text and references have been modified and expanded. The result is one of the most comprehensive and well illustrated atlases of diseases affecting the oral soft tissues, reflecting the author's special experience with dermatological conditions.

This atlas is to be commended to those interested in oral medicine as an excellent pictorial array of most of the spectrum of common and rare conditions seen in the oral soft tissues. Probably my only criticism is of the title, since disorders affecting the teeth, bone and joints are not included.
