It is time that industry – especially in Europe – increases its involvement and activities – and its funding – in this process.

It is our privilege to co-organize this meeting again with the International Society of Cancer Prevention (ISCaP), the European School of Oncology in Milano/Italy (ESO), the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO) and the European Cancer Prevention Organisation (ECPO). New is our association with the European Association of Cancer Research (EACR).

We greatly appreciate your presence in a selected audience of international experts and conference participants interested in cancer prevention from all over the world. We hope you will enjoy the conference and your stay in St. Gallen.
