INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PROSTAGLANDINS AND CANCER 1981

The aim of this meeting is to establish an interaction between prostaglandin scientists and cancer scientists in the areas of carcinogenesis, cell replication, differentiation and host tumour interaction, and to evaluate the therapeutic implications of P.G. manipulation on tumour growth and development in animals and humans.

Each session will have one Chairman involved in prostaglandins and another involved in cancer. There will be four or five lectures in each session which will be delivered by invited speakers having a broad experience in the relevant subject under discussion.
