THIRD EUROPEAN ORGANIZATION FOR RESEARCH ON TREATMENT OF CANCER— NATIONAL CANCER INSTITUTE SYMPOSIUM ON NEW DRUGS IN CANCER THERAPY

Institut Jules Bordet, Brussels, Belgium, 15–17 October 1981

The third European Organization for Research on Treatment of Cancer (E.O.R.T.C.)–National Cancer Institute (N.C.I.) Symposium on New Drugs in Cancer Therapy is scheduled for 15–17 October 1981 at the Institut Jules Bordet, Brussels, Belgium. The symposium will focus on phase I and phase II clinical data including drug pharmacology with investigational anticancer agents. Preclinical aspects in the new drug development area will also be covered with particular emphasis on the role of the human stem cell assay in the screening of new antitumor drugs. The program will include invited presentations and free communications. Free communications will be selected on the basis of submitted abstracts. Abstracts must be received at the E.O.R.T.C.
