### FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT

#### VIITH MEETING OF THE EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION FOR CANCER RESEARCH (EACR)

The Seventh Meeting of the European Association for Cancer Research will be held in Copenhagen, Denmark from 19 to 21 September 1983, and the Danish Cancer Society have kindly undertaken sponsorship of this meeting. The major theme of this meeting will be 'Chemical Carcinogenesis'. Plenary sessions will include presentations by invited speakers and selected papers submitted by the participants. Other communications may be presented in parallel sessions or as posters. The topics of these presentations may be related to any field in cancer research, although papers closely related to the main subject will be considered for inclusion in plenary sessions. The second Otto Mühlbæk Memorial Lecture will also be presented.

A satellite meeting on modifiers of carcinogenesis will follow the main meeting on 22 and 23 September, and this will be organised by Dr. E. Thorling.

The meeting is open to members and non-members of the EACR. Papers may be submitted for presentation by non-members only if sponsored by a member. The deadline for submission of abstracts is 1 May 1983. Abstracts will be evaluated by an International Scientific Advisory Committee, who will allocate presentations to the appropriate sessions. The proceedings of the meeting will be published.

A second announcement will be made towards the end of 1982. At this time, forms for registration, hotel reservation, and abstracts will be available. Members of the EACR will be entitled to reduced registration fees.
