30 May-8 June. Breast Cancer. Veronesi (Milan). Epidemiology, Risk Factors, Biology, Pathology, New Methods of Diagnosis, Evaluation of Mass-screening Programs, Extensive and Conservative Surgery and Reconstruction, Radiotherapy, Adjuvant Chemotherapy, Endocrine Receptors and Hormonal Treatment, Management of Disseminated Disease.

12-19 June. Principles of Medical Oncology. Pinedo (Amsterdam). Chemotherapy and Endocrine Therapy in Advanced Disease, New Treatment Strategies with Growth-inhibiting Drugs, Adjuvant Therapy, Toxicity and Bone Marrow Transplantation, Design and Interpretation of Clinical Trials.

24-30 October. Malignant Melanoma. Levene (London). Epidemiology, Risk Factors, Histologic Classification and Prognosis, Treatment of Primary and Metastatic Tumors, Limbs Perfusion with Drugs and Hyperthermia, Chemo- and Immunotherapies, Late Results and New Perspectives with Monoclonal Antibodies.

7-13 November. Genito-urinary Tract Tumors. Denis (Brussels). Epidemiology, Pathology, Natural History, Tumor Markers, Diagnosis, Staging and Treatment of Tumors of the Kidney, Prostate, Testis and Bladder.

21-27 November. Colorectal Cancer. Goligher (Leeds). Epidemiology, Risk Factors, Pathology, Natural History and Screening Endoscopy, Treatment of Premalignant Lesions, Diagnosis and Staging, Traditional and Conservative Surgery, Use of Staples, Adjuvant Treatments, Rehabilitation.

All the courses will be held at Pomerio Castle, 40 min from Milan. Forty-five students per course. Practical exercises to be held at the Cancer Institute of Milan.
