This project is now being coordinated through the NCI Liaison Office, Brussels, Belgium.

All cancer centers, hospitals or institutions carrying out clinical studies and who are not submitting this information through the national organizations are invited to send protocols and protocol-related data to the NCI Liaison Office for inclusion in the International Cancer Research Data Bank (ICRDB) program.

It is preferable that the protocols be submitted in English whenever possible; however, if the complete protocol is not available, a summary containing the required data elements will be accepted.

All contributors of protocols will receive a copy of the *Compilation of Experimental Cancer Therapy Protocol Summaries*, which is published every year.
