It is a great pleasure for me to pay tribute to Henri Tagnon on the occasion of his retirement this year from the editorship of the European Journal of Cancer and Clinical Oncology.

In his 'Message from the Editor' which appeared in the November issue of our Journal, Professor Tagnon thanks the referees who have given of their time and expertise to maintain the scientific standard of the Journal: to quote him 'they perform one of the most disinterested philanthropic actions and are an encouragement for those of us who keep their faith in human nature'.
