CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE LOCATION OF ECCO 9

The European Conference on Clinical Oncology and Cancer Nursing (ECCO) is organised by the Federation of European Cancer Societies.

It was held in Lausanne in 1981, Amsterdam in 1983, Stockholm in 1985, Madrid in 1987 and London in 1989. This year Florence will host the conference and arrangements are in hand for Jerusalem in 1993 and Paris in 1995.

Proposals are now invited from countries that have not previously hosted an ECCO conference to hold ECCO 9 in 1997. The invitation to host ECCO 9 must emanate from the scientific community of the host country with support from their government.

Congress infrastructure and hotel facilities for up to 6000 people are required. The preferred timing of the conference is early September to mid November.

Preliminary selection will take place during ECCO 6 in Florence and the final decision will be taken during the meeting of the Board of FECS in the spring of 1992.
