Professor V. Craig Jordan Receives Two Major Awards

Professor V. Craig Jordan PhD, DSc, Director of the Breast Cancer Research Program at Northwestern University in Chicago, and an Editorial Consultant for the EJC has been named as the 1996 recipient of the Herbert J. Block Award for Distinguished Achievement Cancer Research by the Ohio State University. The award is made to individuals those who internationally recognised as leaders in their field. Professor Jordan is recognised for his work on the clinical development of tamoxifen.

Previous recipients have been Dr Bert Vogelstein and Dr Judah Folkman.

Professor Jordan has also been named as the 1997 laureate of the Cino del Duca Award in Paris, again for his work over the past 25 years developing the drug tamoxifen as an effective breast cancer therapy. This is recognised as one of the top European awards for oncology. Professor Jordan will be presented with the award at the 7th International Congress on Anticancer Treatments in Paris in 1997.
