## COVER PICTURE

The cover picture shows a rare, 80% silver, round Australian 50-cent piece, which was introduced in 1966 when Australia changed currency from the Australian pound to the Australian dollar. It was later replaced with a copper/nickel dodecagonal (12-sided) version in 1969. The coin underpins the reaction of a silver(I) acetylide with adamantyl iodide affording the bridgehead-substituted adamantylacetylene. This new methodology has nanotechnological ramifications as discussed in the article by C. M. Williams et al. on p. 241 ff. Brett D.
