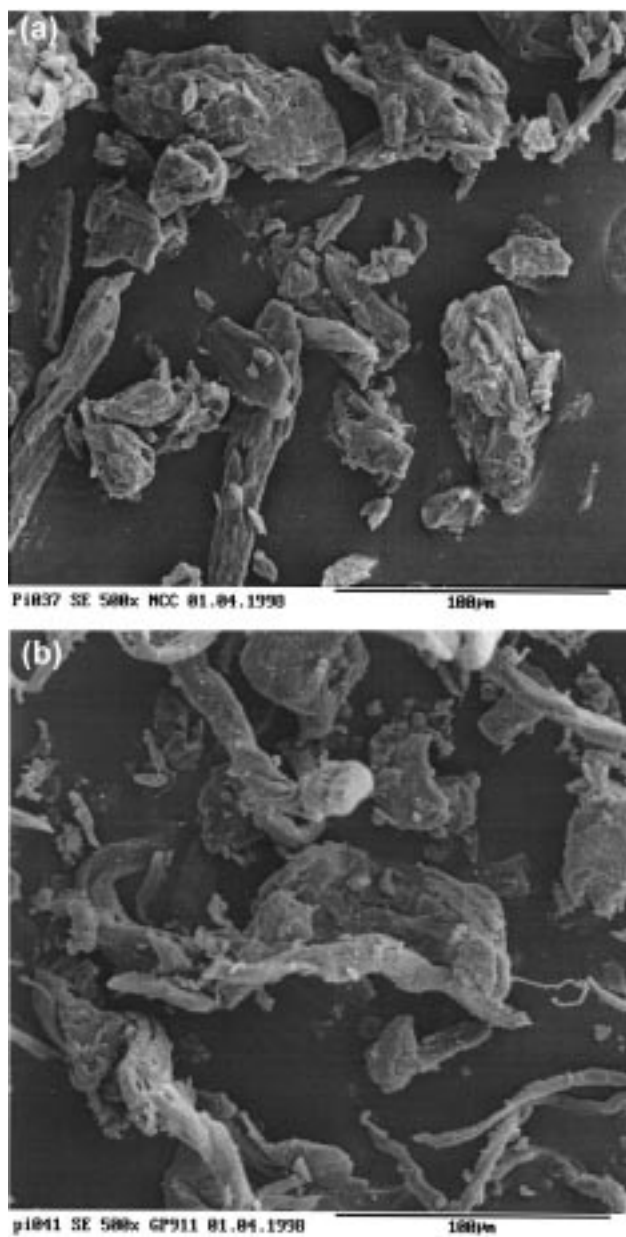


Fig. 1. Scanning electron micrographs of MCC (a) and carrageenan (b) particles (magnification 500X).

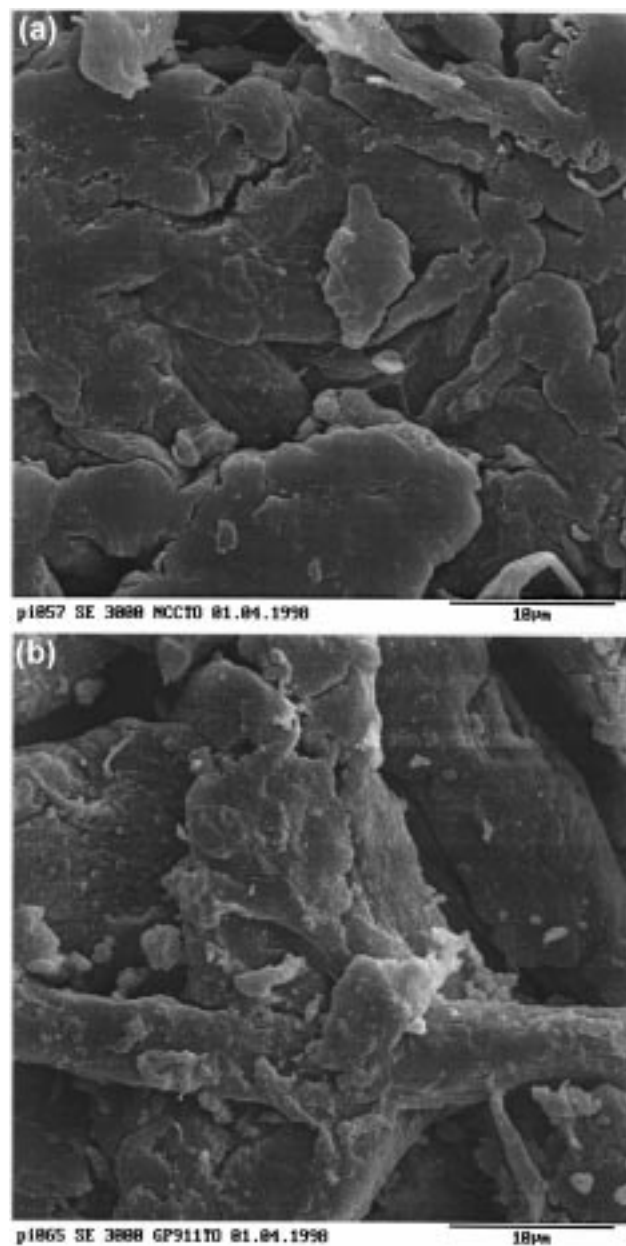


Fig. 5. Scanning electron micrographs of the surface of tablets made of MCC (a) and carrageenan (b) at a magnification of 3000X.
