APV (International Association of Pharmaceutical Technology) gives away this award to support young talents in the Pharmaceutical Sciences and in appreciation of an outstanding doctoral thesis in pharmacy. This award is connected with an amount of 5,000.- Euro kindly donated by **BASF SE** and will be presented at the "8<sup>th</sup> World Meeting on Pharmaceutics, Biopharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Technology" taking place in Istanbul, Turkey, March 19 to 22, 2012.

Every European graduate who has obtained a PhD degree in the Pharmaceutical Sciences in 2010 or 2011 can apply for this award. The applications are reviewed by an international committee.

Written applications consisting of a curriculum vitae, publication list, list of poster presentations and lectures as well as the PhD thesis and a maximum of two reprints of important publications should be submitted as data cd/dvd to the chair of the APV award committee, Prof. Dr. Dr. h. c. ### APV Research Award for Outstanding Achievements in the Pharmaceutical Sciences

APV (International Association of Pharmaceutical Technology) gives away this award every other year in appreciation of outstanding research achievements in the Pharmaceutical Sciences. The award is connected with an amount of 5,000.- Euro and will be presented in the course of the "8<sup>th</sup> World Meeting on Pharmaceutics, Biopharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Technology" taking place in Istanbul, Turkey, March 19 to 22, 2012.

This award is open to any senior researcher in Europe who has made outstanding achievements in the Pharmaceutical Sciences and is not older than 45 years. The applications are reviewed by an international committee.

Candidates may be nominated by regular APV members.
