INTERNATIONAL COURSE ON LABORATORY ANIMAL  
SCIENCE  
Utrecht, 9–20 June 1997

A two-week course on laboratory animal science will be organised at the Department of Laboratory Animal Science, Utrecht, The Netherlands, in June 1997. This course is organised once a year since 1993.

The objective of this course is to present basic facts and principles that are essential for the humane use of animals and for the quality of research.

The contents of the course are in line with recommendations of the Federation of European Laboratory Animal Science (FELASA) regarding the training of the young scientist whose research involves the use of vertebrate animals.

The course may also be of interest for those who intend to set up a similar course at their location. For this

purpose, during the course the acquisition of teaching materials can be discussed with the course committee.
