Editorial announcement

Publication in the Netherlands Journal of Plant Pathology now open for non-members of the Netherlands Society of Plant Pathology

Until now, the right of publishing articles and other papers in the Netherlands Journal of Plant Pathology has been limited to members of the Netherlands Society of Plant Pathology. The board of the society has decided to extend the possibilities of publication. Starting from January 1, 1984, the journal publishes papers not only from society members, but also from subscribers to the journal and from authors who want to publish research that has been carried out at an institute that has a subscription to the journal. If a paper has two or more authors, at least one of them should belong to one of these categories.

The text of the papers should preferably be in English; correct use of the language is obligatory. Each manuscript should contain a Dutch translation of title and abstract. The editors can provide for such a translation for foreign authors. From now, Dutch translations of captions of figures and titles of tables will no longer be required.

For further details concerning the preparation of a manuscript authors are referred to the Hints to authors mentioned on the inside of the back cover of each issue of the journal.
