

EIGHTH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF BIOCHEMISTRY – 1970

The following announcement has been received from the Treasurer of IUB:

The Executive Committee of the International Union of Biochemistry have invited the Swiss Biochemical Society to join the Union in sponsoring the Eighth International Congress of Biochemistry in Switzerland in September 1970 and this invitation has been accepted. The Congress will take place on the same dates as originally planned for the Congress in Rome, namely *3–9 September 1970*, and will be held simultaneously in three centres – Interlaken, Luzern and Montreux. The Scientific Programme is being prepared and an announcement about it, and about arrangements in general together with Registration Forms, will be distributed during October 1969.
