The well-known waveguide nomenclature muddle is exceeded in lack of clarity by the flange nomenclature muddle. For every rectangular waveguide size, which may have several different designations, there are several flanges available, each with its own array of designations. The flange nomenclature muddle may become a major annoyance to those users who use equipment made by different manufacturers in different countries, for manufacturers oftentimes state the flange numbers of a device without stating the waveguide size or flange nomenclature system used.
