Peak-Pulse Power Calibrations Initiated (Correspondence)

The Radio Standards Laboratory at Boulder, Colorado, has inaugurated a new service for the calibration of coaxial RF peak-pulse power meters. This service is available for a frequency band of 950 to 1200 MHz and a peak-power range of 1 mW to 3 kW. Calibrations are performed at pulse widths of 2 to 10 μ s and repetition rates of 100 to 1600 pps, with a maximum duty cycle of 0.0033 due to generator limitations.
