The Rantec Years - Dr. Seymour B. Cohn (1960 to 1967)

Dr. Cohn's research efforts have resulted in major contributions to the microwave community. The broad scope of his work includes design concepts for numerous types of filters, couplers, multiplexers, and even test equipment used to more accurately measure the devices he designed. This paper describes a small part of his activities as Vice President and Technical Director during the Rantec period (1960-1967) as reported by this engineer and friend.
