A Monolithic Ka-Band HEMT Low-Noise Amplifier (1988 Vol. I [MWSYM])

A monolithic, single-stage HEMT low-noise amplifier has been developed for the 20-40 GHz band. This amplifier includes a single 0.25- μm gate-length HEMT active device with on-chip matching and biasing circuits. A gain of approximately 6 dB from 20 to 38 GHz and a noise figure of approximately 5 dB from 26.5 to 38 GHz were measured. These are the best reported results for a millimeter-wave amplifier over this bandwidth. The chip size is 2.2 mm x 1.1 mm.

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
