Recently, two incidents requiring my attention occurred regarding articles submitted to the IEEE Microwave and Guided Wave Letters. The first incident is a near-miss. One of the authors of an accepted article called my office and requested to pull this article from being printed on the grounds that the employer from whom the permission of submission had been granted subsequently reversed the decision. I called the IEEE and asked if the article can be removed from the issue already prepared. It turned out that the article was at the printer, but fortunately could be removed from inclusion in the issue without any additional cost. If it were one day later, a substantial cost would have been incurred. It has been the practice that such a cost would have been borne by the authors or their employer, but not by the IEEE or MTT-S. Note that at the time of submission of the article, the authors certified by way of the author check list and the IEEE Copyright form that all required clearance procedures were followed.
