

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### REGISTRATION AND MEETING ROOM

Symposium registration is in the lobby of the Radio Building of the National Bureau of Standards. Ladies may register at NBS or at the ladies "Get-together" coffee. Registration will be open from 1 until 8 p.m. on Monday, May 21; after 7 a.m. on Tuesday, May 22; and after 8 a.m. on Wednesday and Thursday, May 23 and 24.

All technical sessions will meet in the NBS auditorium which is just off of the lobby area.

### MEALS

During the lunch hour shuttle-bus service will provide access to commercial restaurants. A limited number of sandwiches and cold plates will be available in the lunchroom of the NBS Laboratories.

### ENTERTAINMENT

Gab-fest, Monday, May 21

To renew acquaintances and make some new ones, an informal "Gab-fest" will be held at the Harvest House, Monday evening, 8:00 to 10:00 p.m. Cocktails may be purchased as desired.

Visit and dinner at Air Force Academy, Tuesday, May 22

The technical sessions will be held one hour earlier on this day to provide as much time as possible for a visit to the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs (185 miles round trip). The afternoon session will end at 4:00 p.m. and buses will leave immediately from NBS. Facilities will be available for participants to check papers or printed material at NBS either for the evening or overnight if desired. Buses for the ladies will leave an hour or two earlier.

Upon arrival (about 6:15 p.m.) there will be a bus tour of the Academy grounds, a buffet dinner will be served at the Officer's Club, and then the group will visit several laboratories at the Academy. The group will arrive back in Boulder at about 11:00 p.m. It may be necessary to limit ticket sale to this function and tickets will be sold on a first-come first-served basis.

The banquet will be held at the Harvest House fifth-floor Horizon Room. Dr. W. L. Barrow, a microwave pioneer, will speak on "Reminiscences of a Microwaver."

## TRANSPORTATION

### To and from Denver

If there is sufficient demand they will attempt to arrange special flights for departure from Denver after the Symposium.

### Within Boulder

Public transportation in Boulder is limited. There is one taxi company and buses run between NBS and downtown every thirty minutes. The buses do not offer convenient access to motels or the Harvest House.

To supplement public transportation shuttle transportation by chartered bus will be provided along the route indicated on the map (back cover). This will provide approximately 15-minute service during lunch and at the beginning and end of each day.
