

CALL FOR PAPERS

1964 PTGMTT INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM

The 1964 PTGMTT International Symposium will be held on May 19–21, at the International Hotel, Idlewild Airport, New York, N. Y.

A **Call for Papers** concerned with research, development, and applications in *all areas* of the microwave field is hereby issued. In addition, the Technical Program Committee is interested in concentrating the Symposium on the following areas:

- A) Lasers—With emphasis on the microwave-analogous aspects of these devices.
- B) High-Power Techniques.
- C) Millimeter and Submillimeter Wave Techniques and Components.
- D) Solid-State Devices.

Prospective authors must submit 50–100 word abstracts, and 500–1000 word summaries accompanied by up to six figures. This material should be sent to:

No revisions of the summaries will be permitted after their initial submission except for bringing data up-to-date. Such up-dating will be permitted only if the author informs the Symposium Program Committee of his intention to do this at the time of the original submission. The summaries of accepted papers will appear in a *Symposium Digest*, to be distributed to all registrants.

Deadline for receipt of the above material is December 13, 1963. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be made by January 17, 1964. Publication in the *Digest* will not prejudice later consideration of the complete articles for publication by the IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON MICROWAVE THEORY AND TECHNIQUES. Submission of a complete paper for consideration in a planned special Symposium Issue of these TRANSACTIONS is encouraged.
