

Foreword

This completes ten years of existence for the Professional Group on Microwave Theory and Techniques and, as I write this foreword, it is tempting to review our history. The lack of space prohibits a true review but the names of the ten PGMTT Chairmen recall the dominant events of each year and provide a chronological checklist of our first decade: Warriner, Clavier, Mumford, Beck, Engelman, Pritchard, Saad, Oliner, Tomiyasu, and Anderson.
