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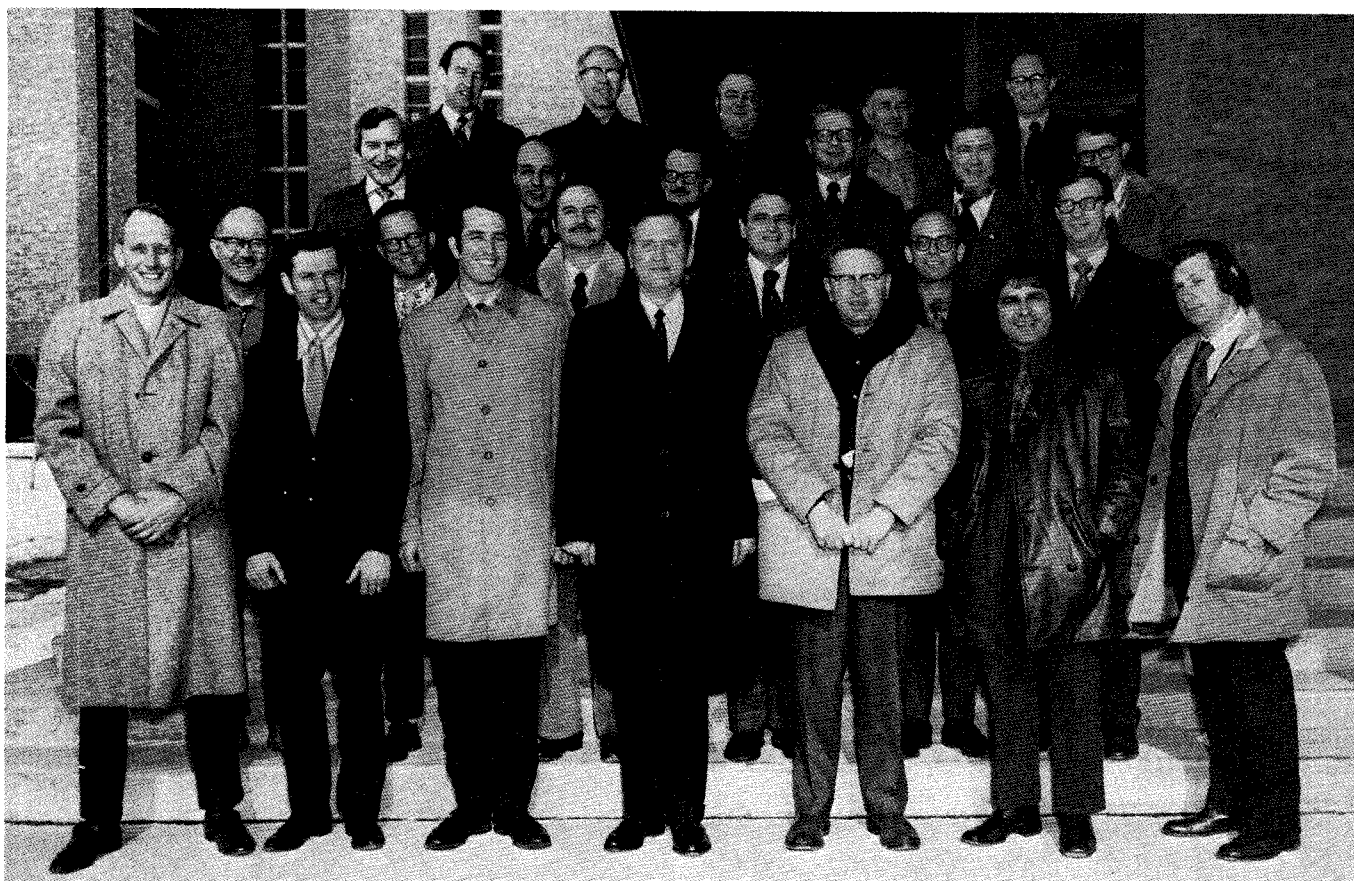

The Boulder-Denver Chapter, G-MTT, takes pleasure in welcoming the 1973 G-MTT International Microwave Symposium to the Colorado University Campus--in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains.
