Motoharu Ohtomo was born in Osaka, Japan, on February 11, 1938. He received the B.E. degree in applied physics from the University of Tokyo, Tokyo, Japan, in 1960.

In 1960 he joined the Tokyo Shibaura Electric Company, Ltd., Kawasaki, Japan, where he was engaged in research and development of ruby maser. Since 1966 he has been working on microwave semiconductor active devices. From 1966 to 1968 he did research work on Gunn-effect devices. Since

1968 he has been working on IMPATT devices, and since 1972 also on TRAPATT oscillators. His works also involve investigation of noise in oscillators.

Mr. Ohtomo is a member of the Institute of Electronics and Communication Engineers of Japan and the Physical Society of Japan.
