Dietrich of Bell Laboratories Inc., Allentown, PA 18103. I welcome Mr. Dietrich and look forward to working with him. The Abstracts are intended to give you the minimum information

necessary to decide whether or not you want to examine the patent in more detail. If so, you should obtain the patent through your regular channels. Complete copies of patents are available for a small fee by writing: U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, Box 9, Washington, DC 20231. The publication of the Abstracts requires judgement on the part of the Editor and Associate Editor and may be incomplete. It is not intended to replace the official, comprehensive publication periodically published in Washington, DC. Mr. Dietrich and I are very interested in your reaction to this service, which we intend to provide on a regular monthly basis.
