As in the past, this year the Microwave and Millimeter Wave Monolithic Circuits Symposium is being held jointly with the MTT-S Symposium. In addition a number of workshops and panels make this week a very full microwave event.

San Francisco and its Bay Area are very rich in sights and in the variety of available entertainment. We have contracted one of the finest agencies to conduct our guest programs. In addition to a variety of excellent tours, we have added a Saturday Wine-Tasting tour through the Wine-Country.
