SPECIAL SESSION IN HONOR OF PROF. A. A. OLINER



Chairman: S. T. Peng—New York Institute of Technology

Session Abstract: Three invited papers in this session review the status of the field, together with applications to contemporary problems, in the context of Prof. A. A. Oliner's past and current contributions to these topics.

Dr. Arthur A. Oliner is Professor of Electrophysics at Polytechnic University in Brooklyn, N.Y. He is a former Department Head, and was Director of its Microwave Research Institute from 1967–1982.

He is author, co-author or editor of 3 books and about 180 published papers, and he received prizes for two of them: The Microwave Prize in 1967 and the Institution Premium of the British IEE, their highest award, in 1964.

He is one of the six present Honorary Life Members of the MTT Society, being elected in 1977, and he was the recipient of the Microwave Career Award in 1982.
